### **CANTEEN every Monday**

We have had 2 Monday lunch canteen deliveries so far, and the response has been fantastic. Thanks to all the parents that put their name down for the roster so quickly, there are step by step instructions on the sign-up genius if you are interested. We had 80 lunch orders on the first day in week 2 and almost 100 in week 3. We also now have set up a system, that if your child has lunch ordered, but is not at the school on that day, the food will be stored in the staff fridge by the front office ladies, for your child to collect from the bridge the next day.

Only the PP lunch orders are delivered to their cabin, all other students need to collect from the galley window through the quarterdeck. If your child likes tomato sauce, we have a tomato sauce station at the end of the bench with a big sign, so they can help themselves. (PP receives a bottle with their basket.) Alternatively, I have spoken to the ORSHS canteen manager and they are looking at adding a small sauce to the order system.

Please note, the Qkr! System set up by the ORSHS and linked to our school. This means any problems and changes cannot be made with ORPS. You would have to ring ORSHS office to be put through to the canteen manager.
