

# RAC Imagine Excursion

Year 5 & 6, April 2021



The Year 5 and 6 students attended an excursion to the Old Mill, South Perth, to participate in an excursion called “The RAC Imagine Program”.

The RAC Imagine Program provided the students with an opportunity to discover past and future technologies, and learn about the changing nature of transport, mobility and road safety, whilst addressing aspects of STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) and HASS subjects (Humanities and Social Sciences).

During the day, the students took part in six activities including a ride on the RAC Intellibus, a tour of the Old Mill, exploring Autonomous Vehicle technology and the future of transport, understanding the connection between coding and road safety> The students undertook a virtual reality ride in the RAC Rescue helicopters, and be hands-on by creating a recycled sculpture to improve the future of mobility.

The students had a really positive experience and will continue to explore the future use of autonomous vehicles and technology in their design and digital technology work.
